### **Treasurer's Report**

Chief Pitcock announced Officer Josh Thompson was the Police Officer of the month of December 2019.

Chief Pitcock announced that Officer Scott Ballman was the Police Officer of the month of January 2020.

The Chief stated there were several officers nominated for the Police Officer of the year and that Officer Ben Norris was selected recipient for the Police Officer of the Year for 2019.

Wendy McCutcheon provided an update of the activities that are planned at the Community Park for the upcoming Summer, activities include: five sponsored movies to be held at the WesBanco Amphitheater beginning in the month of May, in addition, there are also five concert series beginning in the month of May. Wendy said next weekend kicks off baseball tournaments and YMCA soccer games. - C) Hayden Sweat read the second reading of an ordinance amending Chapter 136: Curfew of the Mt. Washington Code of Ordinances. Discussion was held and determined to leave in responsible custodian. Councilman Troutman made a motion to approve and Councilman Holt seconded, motion carried by a roll call vote of 6 to 0.
