**Minutes**

Councilman Armstrong made and Councilman Maddox seconded a motion to approve the minutes of the regular council meeting for April 26, 2021. Motion carried.

**Resolution**

Hayden Sweat read a resolution authorizing the Mayor to enter into a cable franchise agreement with Spectrum. Dustin Armstrong made, and George Maddox seconded a motion to approve. Motion carried unanimously by a roll call vote.
