<p>116.04 LICENSE FEES IMPOSED; RATE. On and after July 1, 1999, there is hereby imposed an occupation tax upon all persons engaged in any any occupation, trade profession, or business, which occupational tax shall be measured and be equal to one percent (1%) of the gross annual salaries, wages, or compensation earned by any such person done for services performed or rendered within the city. Monday through Saturday excluding state or national holidays

*** per Ordinance Chapter 111.02 *** see exception:

(E) No Peddler or solicitor shall engage or attempt to engage in the business of peddling or soliciting at any home, residence, apartment complex or business that prominently displays a "No Peddlers", "No Solicitors", or "No Trespassing" sign or any other similar sign that communicates the occupants desire to not be contacted by peddlers

[111.01 DEFINITIONS.](#)

For the purpose of this subchapter, the following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning: "BUSINESS." The business carried on by any person who is an itinerant merchant, peddler, or solicitor as defined in this section.

"GOODS." Merchandise of any description whatsoever, and includes, but is not restricted to, wares and foodstuffs.

"ITINERANT MERCHANT." Any person, whether as owner, agent, or consignee, who engages in a temporary business of selling goods within the city and who, in the furtherance of such business, uses any building, structure, vehicle, or any place within the city.

"PEDDLER."

- (1) Any person who travels from place to place by any means carrying goods for sale, or making sales, or making deliveries;
- (2) Any person who, without traveling from place to place, sells or offers goods for sale from any public place within the city. A person who is a peddler is not an itinerant merchant.

"PERSON." Any human being.

"SOLICITOR." Any person who travels by any means from place to place, taking or attempting to take orders for sale of goods to be delivered in the future or for services to be performed in the future.

A person who is a solicitor is not a peddler.
