Mayor Armstrong called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM with the following council members present, Troy Barr, Greg Gentry, Sandra Hockenbury, Gayle Troutman, George Maddox, and Dustin Armstrong.

Also present were City Attorney Hayden Sweat, City Administrator Dawn Hardin and Chief Troy Pitcock.

The Mayor stated our county is still in a red zone and will continue to have meetings online.

Councilman George Maddox led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Armstrong asked those present to take a moment of reflection.

Minutes

Councilman Troutman made and Councilwoman Hockenbury seconded a motion to approve the minutes of the regular council meeting for January 11, 2021. Motion carried.

Treasurer Report

Alice Harris provided the Treasurer's report for the month of November and December 2020 including the year to date. George Maddox asked the total revenue we have received for the Property Taxes to date. Alice said we have currently received \$1,294,927.81 to date.

The mayor made a statement regarding the mail delivery delay and stated the water bills are not being assessed a late charge.

Resolution

Hayden Sweat read a Resolution authorizing the Mayor to enter into a lease agreement with New Cingular Wireless PCS aka AT&T Councilman Maddox made a motion to adopt and Councilman Armstrong seconded. Motion carried by a roll call vote of 6 to 0.

- A) Hayden Sweat read the second reading of an ordinance relating to the rezoning request of 167 Snapp Street owned by Jarvis and Josh Real Estate from R-1 Residential to R-3 Residential. Councilman Troutman made and Councilman Barr seconded a motion to accept the recommendation

- B) Attorney Sweat read the second reading of a consensual annexation of 7.2903 acres owned by Spalding Development Inc located on Stringer Lane section 4 of Moore Farms Estates. Councilman Gentry made a motion to approve and Councilman Trautman seconded. Motion carried unanimously by a roll call vote of 6 to 0.


Mayor's Report
